
# How to apply for a CHSS Research Grant

Please access the application portal here.


If you have previously logged in, **login** on the left hand side.

If you are new to the site, please click "Start Application" to create your user profile.



After clicking "Start Application," the system will prompt you to fill out your user profile and Create a New Account. Please do so and then click "Register."

You also have the option to **login** on the left hand side of your screen.



If you have logged in previously, you can view your application under "All Submissions." There, you can access your incomplete applications and continue to edit them.



To start an application, please enter your information, including name, email, gender, degree, current address, country of citizenship, if you have received a research grant before, demographics you fall under, your CV, if you have any other research team members and their CV's, and if you applying for a Southeast Asia or South Asia grant defined as:

## South Asia






In addition, you will need to indicate your research project title, your AAS record number (if applicable), and what disciplines or themes your project covers.

Your application requires 2 letters of reference. In order for AAS to receive these letters, please enter your referee's full name and email address. Once you have done so, please click the button "Send Request Now" which will prompt you to an alert "Are you sure you want to send the request? To which you should respond "OK" to send your referee an email with a link to upload or type their letter in the system. If you need to cancel, hit "Cancel."

You will need to upload a budget for your project, and a writing sample (approximately 2,000 - 2,500 words).

Indicate the duration of the grant project as 2 months or less (short term), 2 - 6 months (medium term), or 6 -12 months (long-term).

Indicate where the project is taking place, the expected completion of the project and/or any anticipated publication dates, and the amount of funding requested. The amount of funding should request the length of the project. Ie. A short term project should request \$2,000, a medium term grant anywhere from \$2,000 - \$6,000, and long term grants \$6,000 - \$12,000.

If you finalize and see an error in your application, as long as it is before the deadline, you can email grants@asianstudies.org to assist you in correcting any mistakes to a finalized application.

The grants will be awarded with the understanding that within two years of completion of their project, the recipients will present the results of their research at an AAS-in-Asia conference, or a similar international conference, with acknowledgment of the award. Any publication based on the funded research should also acknowledge the AAS-Sweden Cultivating the Humanities and Social Sciences Research Grants.
